Adoption Application Overview

Our adoption process typically takes 2–5 days, or up to 7–10 days for purebred or highly sought-after dogs. Please be patient and ensure all details below are complete to help us process your application quickly.

Housing Information

- Renters: Confirm with your landlord or property owner that pets are allowed, including any weight or breed restrictions.
 - o Include their name and contact information—applications without this will not be processed.
 - o Notify them that CCFR will be in touch for verification.
- **Homeowners:** Verify with your city or municipality that there are **no breed restrictions or bans** for the dog you're applying for.

Veterinary Information

- Provide full contact information for your current and/or past veterinarian (not just clinic name).
- Give consent for records to be released to CCFR.
- All resident dogs must be spayed/neutered and up to date on core vaccinations.
- Heartworm testing and prevention are strongly recommended.

Additional Guidelines

- Please **respect all recommendations** listed in each dog's bio, including those related to children's ages and compatibility with cats, to ensure a safe and successful match.
- Yard videos can be emailed to corgisandfriends@gmail.com if not attachable to your application.
- Provide **two personal references** (not relatives, co-applicants, or your vet).
- All family members and resident pets must **meet the potential dog** before adoption.
- We do not adopt out littermates or multiple young dogs together.

Communication & Availability

- Watch your email (and add us to your safe sender list) for updates.
- Due to high demand, we do not hold dogs.
- Please apply only if you're <u>ready to adopt within 7–10 days</u>.
- o If you're moving, traveling, or recovering from surgery, please wait to apply.
